RESPONSE TO AN OFFICIAL INFORMATION ACT REQUEST (REF: DOIA063-2023/24)

On 29 April 2024, you contacted the Ministry for Pacific Peoples (the Ministry) requesting under the Official Information Act 1982 (OIA), information relating to remuneration at the Ministry. I have outlined your request and my response below.

We request... total remuneration positions between \$95k and \$100k.

We have interpreted your request as seeking information on the number of Ministry employees whose salary falls within this range. The Ministry currently has two FTE employees whose salary is between \$95,000 and \$100,000 as of 30 April 2024.
